About the Seminar

India has an estimated 24 lakh people living with HIV (PLHIV) as of 2023, making it one of the countries with the largest HIV-positive populations globally. However, the overall adult (15–49 years) HIV prevalence is relatively low at 0.22%. The number of new HIV infections has declined significantly over the past decade due to expanded prevention and treatment programs. In 2023, there were approximately 60,000 new infections, down from over 100,000 annually in the early 2010s. AIDS-related deaths have also decreased, with around 42,000 deaths reported in 2023, compared to over 150,000 annually in the mid-2000s.

Allied health professionals play a crucial role in the control and prevention of HIV/AIDS through a variety of roles and responsibilities. Their contributions span across education, testing, treatment, and support services. Some of the most important aspects of their contributions in controlling and preventing of HIV/AIDS in India are: 1. Education and Awareness: health promotion, reduction of stigma, taboo and discrimination associated with HIV/AIDS, 2. Testing and Diagnosis: HIV testing and counseling, 3. Treatment and Care: Medical/surgical management, nutritional and dietary support and physical therapy etc. 4. Support Services: Mental health support, social services, 5. Research and Data Management: Epidemiological studies, data analysis, 6. Community Outreach: Targeted interventions, mobile health units, 7. Policy and Advocacy, 8. Training and Capacity Building: Professional training, community training etc.

In conclusion, allied health professionals are integral to the multidisciplinary approach required to effectively control and prevent HIV/AIDS. Their diverse roles ensure that individuals and communities receive comprehensive care, education, and support, ultimately contributing to the reduction of new infections and improved quality of life for those living with HIV/AIDS.
